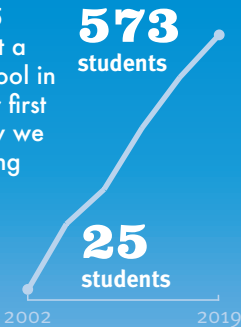
Breakthrough Silicon Valley is changing the statistics. Through our comprehensive six-year program, we help low-income students reach their full potential and achieve their college dreams.

OUR DUAL MISSION

Breakthrough Silicon Valley prepares motivated middle school students with limited educational opportunities for success in rigorous high school programs and entry into four-year colleges. We also prepare outstanding high school and college students to enter careers in education.

OUR IMPACT

Served 25 students at a single school in 2002—our first year. Now we are working with 573 students across San Jose.



99% of Breakthrough students attend college, with 86% attending four-year universities.

96% are the first generation to college

97% have graduated from college, or are on track to graduate within six years

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
